INSTRUCTIONS

1. Entry Fee is \$25 for up to 3 pieces. Entry fee is NON-REFUNDABLE and must be submitted with entry form. All paperwork must be legible.
2. Submission is by digital images only (images may be submitted on a CD or emailed to celisa@cowichecanyon.org). Submit one image of each piece of artwork. Label CD with the artist's name and phone number. Each image file may be no larger than 3 MB and saved as a jpeg file at 72 ppi resolution. Label each image file with Artists' Last Name - Title. Actual artwork must be identical to the submitted images.
3. No media restrictions; sculpture and jewelry encouraged. Work must be original, inspired by the shrub-steppe lands of the Yakima Valley, and have been completed within the past five years. No more than 3 entries per artist. We reserve the right to refuse artwork that is too fragile, oversized or does not meet conditions of eligibility. **All artwork must be delivered display ready, labeled on the back with artist name, title, and price.** Hanging artwork must have hanging wire installed on the back of the piece.
4. A price must be stated for all work. Prices should reflect a 70-30 commission. (70% to the artist; 30% to Highland Food Bank.) All artwork must be for sale.
5. Artists will be notified if their submissions are accepted/declined and of exhibit details by **June 18**.

WHAT IS SHRUB-STEPPE?

Shrub-steppe is a type of arid landscape, made up of native perennial grasses, shrubs, and flowering plants. Historically, shrub-steppe dominated the landscape of Eastern Washington, but today, less than half of Washington's shrub-steppe remains.

Cowiche Canyon Conservancy (CCC) is a land trust working to protect shrub-steppe habitat and connect people to the land. CCC owns and manages 5,000 acres of habitat and offers 30 miles of non-motorized recreational trails. These lands are critical habitat for an array of wildlife, including birds, mammals, reptiles, butterflies, and other insects. cowichecanyon.org
